MONDAY, May 5, 2025
MEETING MINUTES

The Huron Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, May 5, 2025, at 6:00 PM., in the Township Office, 1820 Bogart Road, Huron, Ohio. Present were Chairman Edward Wimmer, Trustee Gordon Hahn, Trustee Ray Enderle, Building Official John Zimmerman, and Fiscal Officer Matt Dewey.

Chairman Wimmer called the meeting to order and led all in attendance in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. Enderle, with a second from Mr. Hahn, to approve the April 7, 2025, minutes as printed. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Mr. Hahn, seconded by Mr. Enderle, to approve the financial report and the payment of bills. The motion passed unanimously.

RESOLUTION 2025-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE HURON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES APPROVING THE COST OF TRUCKS BEDS, PLOWS AND OTHER APPERTANCES FOR THE TWO (2) FREIGHTLINER M2 (106 PLUS) CHASSIS AND CABS RECENTLY PURCHASED FOR THE HURON TOWNSHIP ROAD DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE ODOT COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM (CONTRACT #800-925) IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 9.48 (B, #2).

Mr. Zimmerman explained that this is the Resolution connected to the April 7th motion made by the Trustees to approve the payment to Concord for the plows and equipment to be installed on the new snowplows.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to approve Resolution 2025-08. Mr. Hahn seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Scott Bauman, Boos Road, told the Trustees that Barnes trucks are losing part of their loads of debris from Mucci. He said they are hauling debris from Mucci on Boos Road to their compost site. After a discussion, Mr. Zimmerman was directed to contact both Mucci and the Sheriff's Department in reference to this situation.

ZONING

Mr. Zimmerman reported that 31 permits were issued during the last reporting period. He said there are numerous large projects coming up this year.

ROAD REPORT

The Road Report was accepted and reviewed as submitted by Road Superintendent Eric Boger.

GENERAL

Mr. Zimmerman emailed the monthly Sheriff's Report to the Trustees.

ROUND TABLE

Mr. Enderle said he had received three quotes to remove the stump on Galloway Road. After a brief discussion, Mr. Wimmer said he would call Buckeye Tree Service to get more information.

Mr. Enderle continued that he felt the berm on Milan's side of Scheid should be addressed. Mr. Hahn said he had talked with the County Engineer about the problem. The County Engineer said he would discuss the situation with Milan Township and get back with Mr. Hahn.

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TRUSTEES MINUTES

Mr. Hahn said he had a Summer Employee for the Road Department. He said he had talked with Road Superintendent Boger about the candidate and got his approval. After the discussion, **Mr. Enderle made a motion to hire Paul Maloney, Willow Creek Drive, as the Summer Employee for the Road Department at \$16.00 per hour. Mr. Hahn seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.** Next, **Mr. Hahn made a motion to pay for the Memorial Day flags for the Amvets, not to exceed \$1,500. Mr. Enderle seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.**

Mr. Wimmer asked the status of Valley Ford. Mr. Zimmerman said we have heard nothing

Mr. Enderle made a motion to cancel the May 19, 2025, meeting. With a second by Mr. Hahn, the motion passed unanimously. The next regular meeting is Monday, June 2, 2025, at 6:00 PM.

With no further business for the Trustees, **Mr. Hahn made a motion to adjourn at 6:47 PM, with a second by Mr. Enderle.**
