MEETING MINUTES

The Huron Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, August 4, 2025, at 6:00 PM., in the Township Office, 1820 Bogart Road, Huron, Ohio. Present were Chairman Edward Wimmer, Trustee Gordon Hahn, Trustee Ray Enderle, Building Official John Zimmerman, Fiscal Officer Matt Dewey, and Road Superintendent Eric Boger.

Chairman Wimmer called the meeting to order and led all in attendance in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. Hahn, with a second from Mr. Enderle, to approve the July 7, 2025, minutes as printed. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Mr. Enderle, seconded by Mr. Hahn, to approve the financial report and the payment of bills. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The Trustees were presented the following financial information for Huron Township for the month ending August 31, 2025:

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Isac Reid and Mike Ebert, both residents of the 3600-3700 block of Boos Road, told the Trustees that their properties continue to flood during periods of heavy rain and they said they understand that the last couple of storms deposited large a amount of rain. Both Trustee Wimmer and Road Superintendent Bogar said the Township understands their concerns and we are working on the problem. Mr. Boger said the problem appears to be the size and condition of the discharge pipe from the Boos Road system. He said we are working with Erie County on a solution.

Carol Truman, East Perkins Ave., thanked the Trustees for regulating transient rentals in the Township.

ZONING

Mr. Zimmerman reported that 37 permits were issued during the last reporting period.

RESOLUTION 2025-10

Mr. Zimmerman emailed the monthly Sheriff's Report to the Trustees.


ROUND TABLE
