MEETING MINUTES

The Huron Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, December 1, 2025, at 6:00 PM., in the Township Office, 1820 Bogart Road, Huron, Ohio. Present were Chairman Edward Wimmer, Trustee Gordon Hahn, Trustee Ray Enderle, Building Official John Zimmerman, Fiscal Officer Matt Dewey, and Administrative Assistant Tammy Rutz.

Chairman Wimmer called the meeting to order and led all in attendance in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. Hahn, with a second from Mr. Enderle, to approve November 3, 2025, minutes as printed. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Mr. Enderle, seconded by Mr. Hahn, to approve the financial report and the payment of bills. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The directional sign at Hull and Camp has been hit for the third (3rd) time this year. After multiple accidents, the Trustees have decided not to reinstall the sign.

Ms. Carol Truman, Perkins Ave., thanked the Trustees for their action limiting transient rentals in Huron Township. Rick Scheel, Galloway Road, was at the meeting in Port Clinton with the state representative, who owns transient rentals, and who is pushing HB109. This bill will take control away from all political jurisdictions in the State for transient rentals by allowing them anywhere residential is allowed. According to Mr. Scheel, a large majority of the attendance were not in favor of HB109. All are encouraged to reach out to their representatives.

Mr. Scheel, a member of the Erie County Fair Board, stated that they are looking for new members to take over for the retiring board members. If anyone is interested or knows of someone, please reach out to Mr. Scheel or the Erie County Fair Board.

ZONING

Mr. Zimmerman reported that 27 permits were issued during the last reporting period.

RESOLUTION 2025-14

RESOLUTION OF THE HURON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES, ERIE COUNTY, OHIO REQUESTING THE ERIE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY TO HURON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ERIE COUNTY, OHIO, THE AMOUNT OF TAX GENERATED BY A NEW ONE-HALF MILL, A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH OHIO R. C. 5705.03.

Mr. Zimmerman stated that this discussion will be tabled at this time due to questions by the Erie County Prosecutor.

Next was the discussion about the Huron Fire Department's aerial platform (451) that has been out of service for the past month. To replace 451 with a new aerial, the cost would be approximately \$2.3 million but, purchasing a used 2007 aerial from the Sutphen Corp., would be approximately \$430,000. Currently, the Fire Department is leaning toward purchasing the used apparatus over purchasing a new one. Mr. Zimmerman said he will keep the Board informed.

ROAD REPORT

The Road Report was accepted and reviewed as submitted by Road Superintendent Eric Boger.

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GENERAL

Mr. Zimmerman emailed the monthly Sheriff's Report to the Trustees.

ROUND TABLE

Mr. Hahn said he will be discussing road projects this Thursday with the Erie County Engineer's Office.

Florence Township will be purchasing the 2016 International for \$70,000 while the 2012 will be going on govdeals.com. The Road Department is expecting our new trucks soon.

Street sweeping has completed in the subdivisions.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

A motion was made by Gordon Hahn to enter Executive Session to discuss personnel at 6:15pm. Mr. Enderle seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to close Executive Session and return to the regular session at 6:35. Mr. Hahn seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

There was consideration of hiring Joshua Fox, Architect, as a part-time employee for the Huron Township Bldg. Department to do inspections. Mr. Fox would be hired under the same terms as our part-time Electrical Inspectors. **Mr. Hahn made a motion to hire Joshua Fox as a part-time employee for the Bldg Department. Mr. Enderle seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.**

There will be a special meeting on December 19th at 8 am to handle committee assignments and personnel issues.

Mr. Hahn made a motion to cancel the December 15, 2025, meetings. With a second by Mr. Enderle, the motion passed unanimously.

The next regular meeting is Monday, January 5, 2026, at 6:00 PM.
