MEETING MINUTES

The Huron Township Board of Trustees met on Monday, September 8, 2025, at 6:00 PM., in the Township Office, 1820 Bogart Road, Huron, Ohio. Present were Chairman Edward Wimmer, Trustee Gordon Hahn, Trustee Ray Enderle, Building Official John Zimmerman, Fiscal Officer Matt Dewey, and Administrative Assistant Tammy Rutz.

Chairman Wimmer called the meeting to order and led all in attendance in the "Pledge of Allegiance".

MINUTES

A motion was made by Mr. Enderle, with a second from Mr. Hahn, to approve the October 6, 2025, minutes as printed. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL

A motion was made by Mr. Hahn, seconded by Mr. Enderle to approve the financial report and the payment of bills. The motion passed unanimously.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The Trustees were presented the following financial information for Huron Township for the month ending November 30, 2025:

RESOLUTION 2025-13

RESOLUTION OF THE HURON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES, ERIE COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING THE TAX RATES ESTABLISHED BY THE ERIE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR 2026.

Fiscal Officer Dewey explained that this is an annual review done by the Erie County Auditor. Mr. Hahn stated that this also shows the reduction in cemetery tax with a forgiveness. The rate collected is .3 Trustees are only collecting .1 from Township residents.

A motion was made by Mr. Hahn, seconded by Mr. Enderle to approve Resolution 2025-13. The motion passed unanimously

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There were questions on the ODOT project along SR 6 where they are adding roundabouts and a bike path. Ms. Fratoe, a resident of Four Seasons, stated their HOA has had no contact with the surveyors regarding their subdivision sign and approach. Mr. Zimmerman explained that this is an ODOT project and as, so the Township has absolutely no power. One of the Surveyors was in the office a couple of weeks ago asking questions on existing signage. After consulting with Council Huron Township will not be involved with the signs that are not being removed. New signage will be required to go through the normal process, but existing signs can stay where they are. Mr. Zimmerman recommends that Ms. Fratoe reach out to ODOT, they should have heard from a surveyor by now.

ZONING

Mr. Zimmerman reported that 21 permits were issued during the last reporting period.

Mr. Zimmerman discussed a possible 2 mill fire levy on the ballot May 4th of 2026. The last levy was 1999 for 3 mill continuing levy. This levy currently collects about 2.4 mills, bringing in 560,000 annually with our cost approximately 1.4 mill annually. With no questions from the audience, the Trustees directed Mr. Zimmerman to proceed with the process.

Mr. Enderle discussed widening the cemetery drive, elderly people have issues when walking in grass. Unfortunately, this is not possible due to the plot layout but with the new section that will be resolved.

Mr. Hahn discussed the new crack sealer replacement. The cost is approximately \$49,000 and can be withdrawn from the gas tax account.

A motion was made by Mr. Enderle to approve the purchase of the crack sealer. It was seconded by Mr. Hahn and passed unanimously.

Next Mr. Hahn reminded the audience that street sweeping will start in the subdivisions.

Mr. Wimmer said he had nothing to report tonight.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to cancel the November 17, 2025, meetings. With a second by Mr. Hahn, the motion passed unanimously.

The next regular meeting is Monday, December 1, 2025, at 6:00 PM.

Mr. Hahn made a motion to enter into an Executive Session to discuss Personnel at 6:29pm. The motion was seconded by Mr. Enderle and passed unanimously.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to close the Executive Session and return to regular session at 7:44pm. Mr. Hahn seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

With no further business for the Trustees, **Mr. Enderle made a motion to adjourn at 7:50 PM, with a second by Mr. Hahn.**
